

Foundations Foreman

Primary Function

Candidates will perform many tasks that require physical labor on construction sites in all types of weather conditions. The Foundations Foreman must be punctual, committed to elite quality craftsmanship, bring a positive "can do" attitude, possess leadership skills and take advantage of opportunities to grow in their craft. The Foundations Foreman will direct up to an average of 6 workers with varying degrees of skill level. Works with Project Foreman and Superintendent to assist construction of the overall project.

Responsibilities

- Show a professional and respectful demeanor with clients, co-workers and subcontractors in actions, attitude and language.
- Maintain complete confidentiality of information pertaining to the company and other proprietary information.
- Work with field supervisors to ensure that all material and equipment is available to complete scheduled work.
- Work with job foreman and superintendent to ensure all RCCI code, quality and safety standards are met.
- Productively and accurately construct framing of concrete foundation systems as well as complete set up for flat work.
 (Place and finish flatwork to a professional level is a plus but not required.)
- Meet or exceed client requests and code specifications.
- Interpret construction drawings to form, prep and pour foundations and flat work to meet drawing specifications.
- Keep technical and industry knowledge up to date.

Minimum Requirements

- High School diploma or GED equivalent.
- Hold a valid driver's license with a driving record deemed insurable.
- Minimum of two (2) years' experience in framing of concrete foundation systems.
- Leadership skills with the ability to work independently and as a team.
- Must have a well-rounded understanding of grading and sitework as well as wood framing, steel framing and other trades coming before and after that directly interface with foundation phase.
- Ability to read and understand Construction Drawings and/or instructions from supervisors in order to efficiently perform jobsite layout and organize materials, labor, etc.
- Must be able to solve basic mathematical problems quickly and accurately.
- Proven ability to identify and resolve complex issues related to foundations and flat work.
- Time management: Proven ability to establish and complete tasks by a deadline.
- Proven ability to organize and prioritize schedules, tasks and allocation of materials and man power.
- Willing and able to train Apprentices and perform other duties and tasks as assigned.
- Must be able to satisfactorily complete safety programs as required.
- Ability to lift 100 lbs.
