Primary Function

Responsibilities

- Minimum of one (1) years’ on site leadership experience and (7) years’ experience in all phases of building (e.g. layout, site work, framing, concrete foundation systems, siding, finish carpentry with knowledge of plumbing and electrical systems).
- Skilled as a Journeyman Carpenter or higher with expert problem solving and finish skills.
- Leadership skills with the ability to work independently and with a team.
- Ability to read and understand CD’s in order to measure, mark, layout and arrange materials based on blueprints, drawings and/or instructions from supervisors so as to complete assigned projects.
- Must have a thorough understanding of carpentry principles and methods and able to solve basic mathematical problems quickly and accurately.
- Computer literate in MS Office suite, Buildertrend, Blue Beam and etc.
- Proven ability to establish and complete tasks, organize and prioritize schedules and allocate resources by a deadline.
- Willing and able to train field personnel and perform other duties and tasks as assigned.
- Must be able to satisfactorily complete safety programs as required.
- Ability to lift 100 lbs.
