Primary Function

Candidate is responsible for assisting the site Superintendent to oversee daily operations, run crews and to ensure the completion of projects in a safe and efficient manner. Foreman must be punctual, an expert in problem solving, able to perform quality craftsmanship in all phases of construction including finish work, bring a positive “can do” attitude, possess leadership and training skills and take advantage of opportunities to grow in their craft. Works field personnel to assist construction of the overall project.

Responsibilities

- Demonstrate a professional demeanor with clients and co-workers in actions, attitude and language.
- Maintain positive and respectful relationships with other employees, subcontractors and clients.
- Maintain complete confidentiality of information pertaining to the company and other proprietary information.
- Direct, train and lead field personnel to complete jobs within the scheduled timeframe.
- Assist Superintendent to train employees on field techniques, layout, safety, and power tool operation.
- Assist Superintendent to ensure all RCCI code, quality and safety standards are met.
- Ensure accuracy of work by checking completed projects and correcting problems as needed.
- Creative achievement of desired outcomes of client and able to meet code specifications.
- Interpret construction drawings and build structures to meet drawing specifications.
- Keep technical and industry knowledge up to date.

Minimum Requirements

- Hold a valid driver’s license with a driving record deemed insurable.
- Minimum of one (1) years’ leadership and training experience and (5) years’ experience in all phases of building (e.g. layout, framing, concrete foundation systems, siding, and finish carpentry).
- Skilled as a Journeyman Carpenter or higher.
- Team player with ability to effectively lead crews and perform other duties and tasks as assigned.
- Ability to read and understand CD’s in order to measure, mark, layout and arrange materials based on blueprints, drawings and/or instructions from supervisors so as to complete assigned projects.
- Able to solve complicated framing and finish issues.
- Must have a thorough understanding of carpentry principles and methods and able to solve basic mathematical problems quickly and accurately.
- Time management: Proven ability to establish and complete tasks by a deadline.
- Proven ability to organize and prioritize schedules, tasks and allocation of resources.
- Team player with ability to effectively lead crews and perform other duties and tasks as assigned.
- Must be able to satisfactorily complete safety programs as required.
- Ability to lift 100 lbs.
